- Know about the work of a Welsh author writing in English.
- Be able to comment on the form and language of the work of a Welsh author writing in English.
- Be able to appraise the work of a Welsh author.

Unit 4: Towards a Bilingual Society in Wales

This unit explores the development of a bilingual society in Wales.

The learner will:

- Understand the importance of bilingualism in Wales.
- Know about the historical struggle to preserve the Welsh language.
- Know the recent interventions to support the Welsh language.

Unit 5: Leisure Time in Wales

This unit allows learners to explore ways in which leisure time is used in Wales and how this has changed in recent years.

The learner will:

- Understand the concept of 'leisure time'.
- Know the range of leisure opportunities in Wales.
- Understand the social and economic importance of leisure activities.

Unit 6: Music and Musicians of Wales

To introduce and explore Welsh music in its broadest definition – traditional, modern, vocal and instrumental, composing and performing.

The learner will:

Understand musical tradition in Wales.

Know about Welsh musicians and their work.

Know about Welsh composers and their work.
